Dr. Purssell is working at identifying the appropriate contact for you to share information with to better achieve results.








Project Spotlight

It's a Technical Knock Out for Electronic Pre-Printed Orders!



Pre-printed orders have changed the game for complex patients in the hospital. Commonly used orders that are evidence based are now easier to fill out, and harder to forget. They are clearly an enhancement to patient care.

But filling out PPOs on paper can be time consuming, and still suffers from common order writing pitfalls such as poor legibility, inaccuracy, and incompleteness. Simply finding the right order set in the filing cabinet can seem to take forever.

Electronic versions of our pre-printed orders bring multiple enhancements. They are legible, easy to store and search on a computer, can automatically fill in critical information such as dates and time stamps, and can improve accuracy with pre-populated choices, automatic warnings, and correct spelling and dosing.

The electronic PPO project is taking our usual order sets and converting them to electronic formats to make physician lives easier, and patient care safer and more effective. Currently the process of creating the electronic PPOs is underway. Interested physicians should contact Dr. Mountain with requests for specific order sets that they would like to see in electronic format. Once the order sets are ready to use, interested physicians will be asked to trial them and provide feedback for further enhancements.
