This inaugural regional roundtable discussion was a productive step towards an improved regional working relationship. Through facilitated discussion, we were able to address the classic "us vs. them" barrier between Physicians and IH Administration and speak frankly about our challenges, frustrations, and desires for improving patient care and physician satisfaction.

One of the key outcomes from this process was recognizing that we must strengthen our local and regional physician structures so that these are even more effective vehicles to address physician concerns. This also includes clarifying the roles and expectations for local physician leadership positions, such as department head roles. There is also an appetite for this to be applied to administration positions, so we have a better idea of the local administrative hierarchy and responsibilities. We look forward to inviting Dr Hundal back in the fall to share in his expertise in optimizing physician meeting structure and roles.

In the end, after a productive roundtable discussion and relaxed evening of conversation at the CAFÉ/AGM, I'm left with the feeling that there is more that unites us than divides us. It is too easy to fall back into the classic roles of physician and administrator. We must remember that we are truly partners in our efforts towards making positive changes in Kootenay Boundary, and success will come easier by working together. And besides, it's more fun, too.
